

- ❖ In 2002 the Base developed a pilot solar project consisting of 12 solar lights, 8 streetlights and 4 flashing beacons

 - Commanding General



- ❖ During 2003, as part of an UESC, 112 solar lights were installed

SOLAR LIGHTS



- ❖ Also during 2003, the Base used in-house funds to purchase 95 additional solar lights for anti-terrorism protection and for use as primary lighting, with 1,000 watt MH lights as backup
- ❖ More than 200 solar lights were installed Base wide
